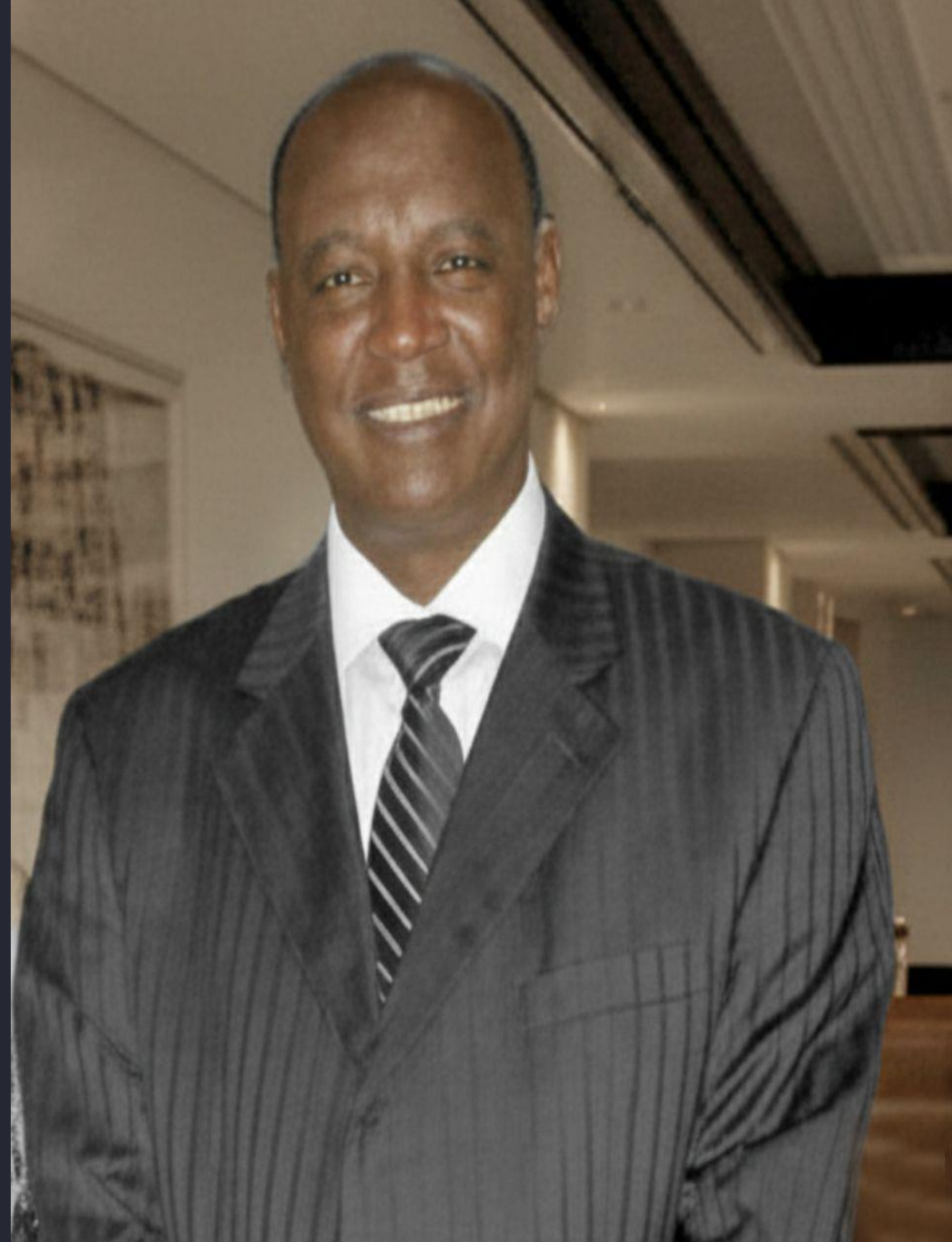

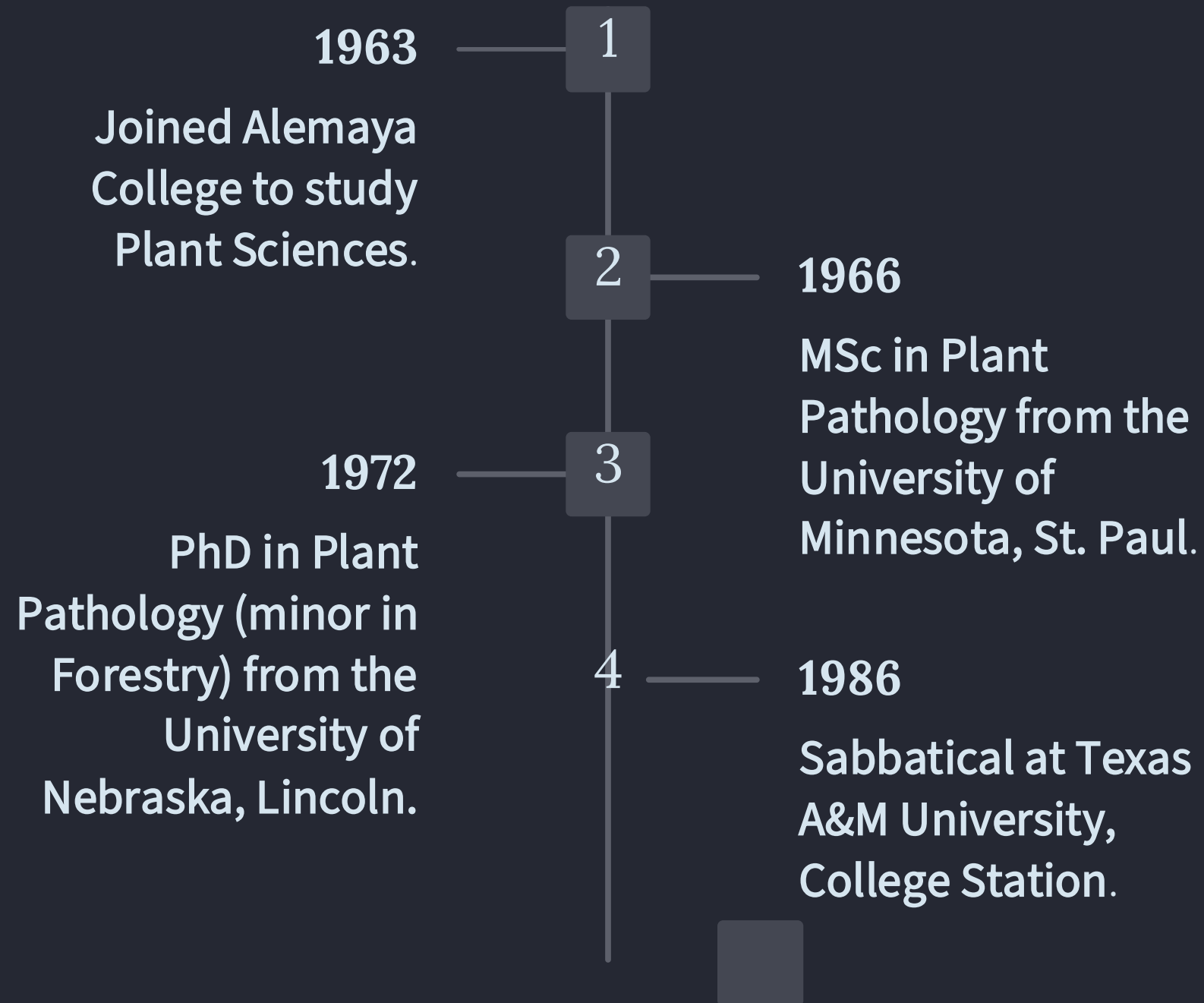
# Early Life & Academic Brilliance

Born in Addis Ababa, Dr. Mengistu Hulluka defied initial expectations to pursue a formal education. He began at Kedamawi Haile Silase (Currently Kokebe Tsibah high) Elementary School, quickly distinguishing himself as a top student.

His academic excellence led him to Jimma Technical High School, a collaboration with Oklahoma State University, and later to Alemaya College for Plant Sciences.

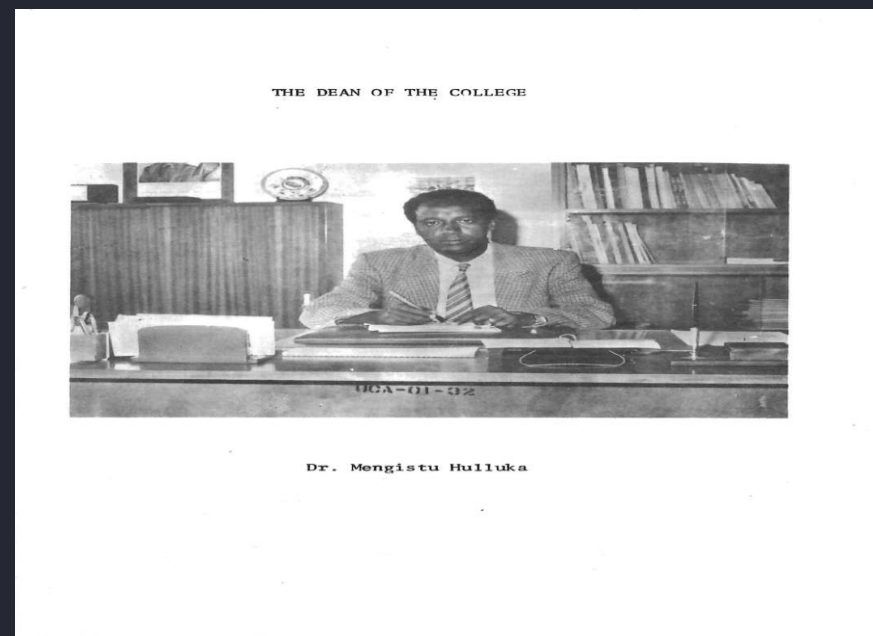

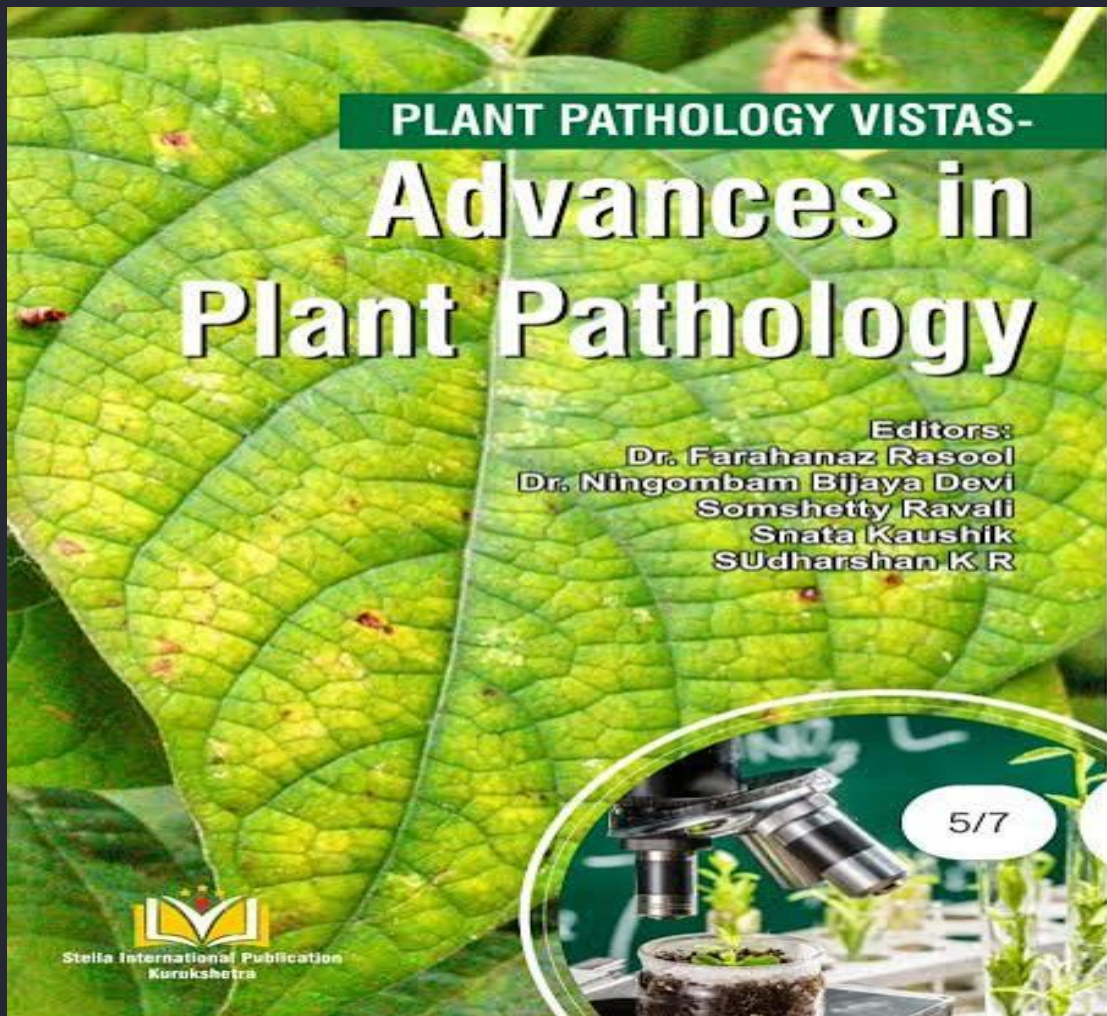
